

ONE-ACT PLAY CALENDAR 2008-2009

August 15	One-act play planning meetings may start August 15 and should be held before administrators organize the Spring Meet districts.
October 1	Last day for filing One-Act Play Enrollment Cards for high schools.
December 21	Last day for submitting plays NOT on approved lists for consideration as one-act play entries & last day for requesting additions to basic set. Note: Each request must be accompanied by a \$25.00 reading/evaluation fee.(Set additions for plays not on the approved lists shall be submitted along with the request for play approval.) Refer to OAP Section 1033 (c) in the current <i>Constitution and Contest Rules</i> or <i>Handbook for One-Act Play</i> .
January 15	Title entry cards mailed to participating high schools.
February 1	Last day for organizing Spring Meet. (One-act play planning meetings must be held before this date.) Deadline for setting up Meets for on-line entry. This should be done by the district academic chair or a designated individual. Deadline for securing a critic judge.
February 23	Last day for filing One-Act Play Title Cards. A #10 self-addressed stamped envelope shall be submitted with the title card in order to obtain an eligibility notice.
March 23 - 28*	First week for holding academic and one-act play zone/district Spring Meets. Eligibility Notices must be postmarked and on-line entry completed 10 days prior to your first contest.
March 30 - April 4	Last week for holding academic and one-act play zone/district Spring Meets. Eligibility Notices must be postmarked and on-line entry completed 10 days prior to your first contest.
April 6 – April 11**	Area One-Act Play Contests for all conferences.
April 23 - 25**	Regional Spring Meet (Academic and One-Act Play Contests).
May 7 - 9	3A, 2A, 1A - 83rd Annual State Meet One-Act Play Contest & Academic State Meet.
May 15-16	4A, 5A 83rd Annual State Meet One-Act Play Contest

* OAP Contests scheduled prior to this week must be approved by the UIL Speech Director, Jana Riggins.
