- Coaches will need to check their contestant(s) in and have them in their assigned seat prior to 8:10 a.m.
- All contestants must wear their name tag. The name tags must be visible prior to beginning the test and during the test.
- All personnel except for the contestants, the director, and the three assistants will be asked to leave the room at 8:15 a.m.
- The test will begin at 8:22 a.m.

### **Test Proofing and Grading**

Coaches of the regional team champions and the coaches of the regional wild card teams will be needed to proof the state test (while the contestants are testing) and grade the tests.

You must be willing to stay in the proofing/grading room until all grading is complete.
