

## Subchapter G. COMMITTEE MEETINGS AND APPEALS

### Section 100: GENERAL

This subchapter consists of policies of The University of Texas at Austin.

When it is necessary for a district executive committee, the Waiver Review Board, or the State Executive Committee to make a determination with regard to the applicability of UIL rules to persons within the jurisdiction of the UIL, including eligibility cases or alleged violations of UIL rules, the applicable committee shall have the option of making a decision on the matter based upon written submissions or convening an informal meeting to discuss the matter in an effort to achieve an equitable resolution. Cases involving school district personnel shall be heard by the State Executive Committee pursuant to the rules adopted by the State Executive Committee.

If a decision is made to hold an informal meeting, the interested parties should be given written notice of the meeting and invited to attend. All decisions by committees shall be in writing, whether based upon a written submission or testimony at an informal meeting.

### Section 150: APPEALS

- (a) APPEALS TO THE STATE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE. Decisions by a district executive committee to disqualify a school or to issue a reprimand to school district personnel, or decisions involving alleged discrimination under the provisions of Section 360 may be appealed to the State Executive Committee which shall have the discretion to either accept or decline the appeal. If an appeal is accepted by the State Executive Committee, it shall have the option to render a decision in the matter based upon either a written submission or an informal meeting wherein interested parties are invited to appear and present testimony concerning the facts at issue.
- (b) APPEALS OF DISTRICT ASSIGNMENT. See Sections 354-356.
- (c) APPEALS OF DECISION OF WAIVER OFFICER. Decisions of the Waiver Officer may be appealed to the Waiver Review Board. See Section 466.
